With the addition of Edgenuity as a learning platform for our students, grading and feedback reporting at PPMS will be slightly different than in years past. Parents have been enrolled in Edgenuity's progress report feature where you will receive weekly progress reports for your child's Edgenuity classes. Courses with Edgenuity will not have grades entered in INOW until the end of the semester. Please see weekly progress reports for more information about your child's progress. Edgenuity's progress reports will have an **overall grade** (reflects grade based only on completed assignments) and an **actual grade** (based on proficiency and student pacing). If a student is behind on his/her pacing, the actual grade will be lower than the overall grade. Courses without Edgenuity will enter grades into INOW. Feedback on student work will be given via Google classroom. Please see the table below for more information.
