



PPMS PARENT EXPECTATIONS

- Ensure your child checks weekly agendas in Google classroom each week. All reminders and assignments will be posted in the agenda, Google stream, and classwork tab.
- Parents of remote learners should make sure students are spending approximately 30-45 minutes daily in each subject. Some subjects may take longer to complete.
- Ensure your child takes notes during instruction. Notes can be used on tests and quizzes.
- Parents should contact classroom teachers for questions or concerns through the teacher's PCS email during the school day. Secondary teachers will be teaching classes during the day and may only be able to respond during their plan period. Please allow 24 hours for a response.
- If your child is locked out of an assignment, have them move to a different content area/ subject until the teacher can unlock the assignment or quiz. After school hours, the assignment may not be reopened until the following school day.
- Monitor grades and progress
 - Edgenuity classes
 - Check weekly Edgenuity reports via email
 - Enroll in Edgenuity Parent Portal for access to student grades and courses
 - Final semester grade from Edgenuity will be posted in INOW
 - Google classroom classes
 - Grades will be posted in INOW throughout the semester
