



PPMS STUDENT EXPECTATIONS

All PPMS Students

- Check Google classroom for weekly agendas, work reminders, and announcements
- Take your time on assignments and take notes in your classes. (You can use notes on your tests and quizzes!)
- Monitor Grades
 - Edgenuity classes
 - Monitor ongoing grades in Edgenuity
 - One semester grade for Edgenuity classes will be posted in INOW
 - Google classroom classes
 - Check grades in INOW throughout the semester
- Communicate with teachers via Google classroom, Edgenuity, or in-person
 - If you are locked out of an assignment, move to a different content area/subject until your teacher can unlock the assignment.

Traditional Students

- Attend class on the PPMS campus on scheduled days/ scheduled periods for blended students.
- Wednesdays and E-Learning Days
 - All PPMS students work from home
 - PPMS staff recommends that students log into classes during their traditional class times
 - Students should expect to spend approximately the same amount of time on virtual work as traditional school work
 - Work in Edgenuity (catch up or get ahead) in each class

Remote Students

- Attend school “virtually” Monday - Friday
 - Complete assignments for all 7 classes, including core and electives
 - PPMS staff recommends that remote students follow their traditional schedule to stay on pace with remote coursework
 - Students should expect to spend approximately the same amount of time on virtual work as traditional school work
 - Teachers will monitor instruction through virtual platforms, but there will not be any live teaching of courses. Some courses may have recorded teacher videos of certain concepts, but this is not a district requirement.
- Attend Regularly Scheduled Google Meets (Wednesdays)
